#### **OBJECTIVES**

Prem Ashram Charitable Trust, Amadalli was registered on January, 10 2008. Registration Number is KWR-4-00043/07-08. The <u>vision</u> of Prem Ashram Charitable Trust is to <u>decrease illiteracy</u>, <u>poverty</u>, <u>hunger</u>, <u>and disease</u> substantially among the underprivileged and socially disadvantaged citizens. The <u>mission</u> of the Trust is to create and support programs that will lead to sustainable changes aimed at upliftment of the lives of economically and socially disadvantaged youth, women, senior citizens, and disabled citizens irrespective of religion, cast, gender, color, and creed.

#### A. Education

Initial focus is on increasing literacy among the youth in villages. We firmly believe that increased literacy will lead to a decrease in poverty.

- Enable the economically and/or socially disadvantaged youth to obtain education and/or vocational training so that the they can get a satisfying job, and support themselves and their families. Thus, the underprivileged youths will be self-reliant, responsible, and productive citizens.
- Participate in the social and cultural development of all youth regardless of economic and social status.

#### B. Health

Strive to decrease disease among the lesser privileged children, women, and senior citizens by organizing health (medical, dental, and eye) camps. Provide information on nutrition and good hygiene and financially help the needy, underprivileged citizens with part of their medical expenses.

**Tele Health**- Bring point-of-care vital information collecting devices to people living in remote villages where doctors do not go so that faster and improved access to healthcare is provided to them.

#### C. Poverty/Hunger

Provide support and services to empower and enhance quality of lives of economically and/or socially disadvantage children, women, and senior citizens.

#### **D. Women Empowerment**

Enable the rural girls to get high school and college education. Create an environment for rural women where they can make decisions of their own for their personal benefits as well as for the society. Services provided may involve counseling, vocational training, and helping to be self reliant.

#### E. Serve the Physically Challenged

Champion programs for the lesser privileged, physically challenged people with a commitment to make them productive citizens of our society. This may involve screening, medical treatment, if necessary, counseling, vocational training, and making them self reliant.

#### **Focus**

Initial focus is on increasing literacy among the underprivileged children. Women's empowerment and Health/Poverty Programs will also be done. Other activities will be taken up as more funds become available.

#### ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT BETWEEN 1/4/2020 - 31/3/2021

The main objectives of the Prem Ashram Charitable Trust are to decrease illiteracy, poverty/hunger, and disease among the lesser privileged people. Providing education (increasing literacy) is the current focus as it would empower and enable the rural, underprivileged youths to find decent jobs and support their families financially. Thus, the underprivileged youths will be self-reliant, responsible, and productive citizens.

#### A. EDUCATION PROGRAMS—INCREASE LITERACY

Total of Rs. 1,094,015.40 spent on all Educational Programs (including Hostel)

- Girls' Hostel at Asnoti for the Poor Girls from Remote Villages
   Although we inaugurated our new Girls' Hostel building on March 1,
   2020, hostel remained unoccupied for many months in FY 2020-21 be cause of school closure due to Covid-19 Pandamic.. Rs. 167,849 were
   spent on Hostel Program. In FY 2020-21.
- Partially Financially Supported Boys' Hostel at Asnoti
   Prem Ashram Charitable Trust contributed Rs. 50,000 (as part of their boarding expenditure) to Boys' hostel for poor, rural students managed by Shree Shivaii Vidva Mandir High School. Asnoti.
- 3. Financial Assistance of Rs. 769,600 was Provided to 705 poor Students Towards Education-Related Expenses

There are many students in Uttar Kannada district who are struggling to pay fees for attending schools and colleges. Upon receiving requests for financial assistance for educational purpose from many primary to post-graduate level students, our trust provided financial assistance totaling **Rs. 769,600** to **705** poor students from several schools and colleges. ## 4. Rs. 83,186.40 in Other Education-Related items Benefitted More than 500 Students from Several Schools and Colleges.

Tables, chairs,desk-cum-benches, uniforms, fans, water filters, utensil racks, cookers, notebooks, study materials, etc. worth Rs. 83,186.40 were provided upon receiving requests from several schools and colleges. These items benefited more than 500 students in various schools & colleges.





#### **B. PROGRAMS TO ENHANCE HEALTH**

Organized the following activities to enhance health.

#### 1. Blood Donation Camp

Blood donation camp was organized in Civil Hospital, Karwar as a part of Mahatma Gandhi's 151st Birth Anniversary on October 2, 2020 in collaboration with Azad Youth Club, Kallur Education Trust, and HDFC Bank.



#### 2. Financial Help to the Poor Towards Medical Expenses

Many BPL people are unable to pay the medical bill when they have a major illness, surgery etc. Some such people approached our trust for financial help for paying medical expenses. Total of Rs. 99,500 were given to 19 BPL persons towards their medical expenses. They were hearing impaired, blind, paralyzed, patients with cancer, epilepsy, stomach disease, etc. and some underwent surgery.

#### C. ACTIVITIES TO ALLEVIATE POVERTY/COVID-19 RELIEF



Many laborers and poor people suffured a lot because of the lockdowns due to Covid-19 Pandamic. Financial help totaling Rs. 147,800 was given to about 168 BPL people who contacted our Trust for help as they could not make both ends meet. Some beneficiaries were older and

women who were not able to earn their livelihood due to an old age/sickness. 162 people received food kits enough for 1-2 weeks.







#### **Celebration of International Women's Day**



International Women's Day was celebrated in conjunction with Azad Youth Club, Karwar. Dr. Kalpana Kervadikar, Principal, Arts & Science College, Karwar was honored and felicitated for her long service as a teacher and an administrator. She rose to the highest position at this autonomous university and became an ideal for others ladies to follow.

#### Celebration of Mahatma Gandhi's 151st Birth Anniversary

As a part of Mahatma Gandhi's 151st Birth Anniversary celebration a Blood Camp was conducted at the Civil Hospital on October 2, 2020 in collaboration with Azad Youth Club, Kallur Education Trust, and HDFC Bank.

## Protective Supplies given to Gram Panchayat Amadalli and Tahsildar Office, Karwar. Rs. 2000 paid to 7 Nurses in Amadalli & Mudga.



There was a scarcity of protective equipment such as N-95 masks and sanitizers because Covid-19 was in full swing and the supplies were depleting fast.. Our trust provided 200 N-95 masks and 20 Liters of sanitizer to Gram Panchayat, Amadalli and Tahsildar Office in Karwar.

Rs. 2000 each was paid to seven nurses from Amadalli & Mudga

PHCs in appreciation of their services during Covid-19 pandamic.

#### **Closing Remarks**

Education of underprivileged rural youths, especially girls, has been the focus of our trust. We had been providing financial assistance for education and hostel facility for the poor girls. New hostel building with 36 capacity was inaugurated on March 1, 2020. It is our hope that the students that we help educate will in turn help other underprivileged children when they start earning and such chain reaction will lead to the sustainable upliftment of the lesser privileged and socially disadvantaged citizens of our society. More efforts were put on projects on enhancing health and reducing poverty because of Covid-19 Pandamic.
